Mallow Cottage has several features that make it a place to explore and enjoy in itself. A short walk takes you to the large dam that has several species of birds, ducks and occasionally visiting swans. A canoe is provided for you to paddle around and enjoy or to fish from. The dam is stocked with murray cod, silver perch and yellowbelly.

Within easy paddle is a Summer House overlooking the creek that flows into the dam. Although this was built by Andrew as a family retreat – you are welcome by arrangement to paddle there and take a picnic or even utilise the outdoor wood fired oven Andrew also built. The views from the deck are beautiful, surrounded by the sights and sounds of the creek, the dam and birdlife.

There is plenty of scope for bush walks on the property and with prior arrangement Andrew may be able to take you on a farm tour. This is a working farm and you may see sheep grazing, being mustered, yarded or even shorn. The old woolshed is interesting but not in good repair so not to be explored without Andrew's guidance.
